This artwork will be created with repurposed materials that are used to have a meaningful use but have been discarded. Consider some of the older things laying around your house that you would likely toss during your next Spring cleaning. As you go about your life these coming days, set items aside that adhere to the guidelines below:

Examples of appropriate items

- Outdated technology
 - Phones, iPod, digital camera, remote control, (**NO** screens or monitors).
- Old household items
 - Broken toaster, cosmetic containers, old CD/DVDs, ripped jeans, old kitchen spatula.

There are many random things that apply, get creative as you look around your life! Whatever you choose, just be sure it falls within the parameters below:

Types of acceptable material:

- Durable materials that are not flimsy or deteriorating
- Nothing fragile, heavy, large or dangerous
- **NO** glass, ceramics, sharp objects, etc.
- **NO** flammable, pressurized or combustible items
- **NO** large items like car tires, wheels, appliances - **nothing larger than about 12 inches.**
- Items should be clean, no odors or possibility of going rancid
- Anything that has absorbed smells, stains or odors will **NOT** be accepted.
